NO CHECK-IN AFTER SHOW STARTS All animals must be checked in prior to showing

Pre-Entry Fee: \$6.00 per goat, per class, per show (Entries postmarked 10/20/08 and before)

Late Entry Fee: \$9.00 per goat, per class, per show (Entries postmarked 10/21/08 and later)

******New this year- This is a wether and doe show only!!! Due to lack of entries for buck show!**

Showmanship: No entry fees for showmanship

Pen Fees: \$4 per pen. Pen size is 8' x 8'. Bring tarps/covers and/or plastic netting for goat babies or for goats that are "jumpers." **NO BEDDING is provided and you are not allowed to use our own bedding.** If you plan to come the night before you may want to keep goats in your own trailers. You can keep them in the pens BUT NO BEDDING IS ALLOWED. Sorry for inconvenience but this helps keeps show cost down.

Eligibility Rules: Youth must be 18 years and younger. They need to be the primary showman of animals entered. Animals need to be in child's name or family name.

Registration Papers: Only animals with original registration papers or transfer of ownership (less than 90 days old) and registration papers will be allowed to show (with the exception of wethers.) NPGA requires all bucks, does, and wethers must be tattooed or micro chipped if six months or older to be eligible to be shown. Registration papers must be brought for check in at the show and must **STAY** on the fairgrounds while animals are being shown.

NPGA Rules: Exhibitors may show any doe, or wether no matter what the herd name of the animal. Herd name rule does not apply to youth shows. Although the show chair, secretary or designee will check the registration papers prior to the goat being shown to ensure that each goat had been entered in the correct class and division, it is the ultimate responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure their animal is being shown in the correct age class and division.

Health Check: Only healthy animals allowed on fairgrounds. Animals with obvious signs of illness -- runny noses, eyes, coughs -- will be requested to leave; entry fees will not be refunded.

Awards: Rosette ribbons are awarded for 1st thru 8th places in each class. Participation Ribbons for placing after 8th NPGA rosette ribbons are awarded to the Champion and Reserve Champion in each division and to the Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion in the Registered Doe. Also NPGA Ribbons for Best Wether and Reserve Best Wether.

Raffle: A raffle will be held Saturday at the lunch break!!
