**NPGA RULES TO GOVERN. NPGA SANCTIONED.** Only animals with original registration papers or registration papers with transfers less than ninety (90) days old will be allowed to show. Wethers do not need registration papers to be shown. NPGA rules now require all animals over 6 months old be tattooed or microchipped to be shown. Exhibitors shall not show any doe or buck in an NPGA-sanctioned show with the herdname of the judge who is judging that show. This does not apply to wethers.

**BRING ONLY HEALTHY ANIMALS** - Only healthy animals allowed on the fairgrounds. Animals having runny nose or eyes, coughs or other obvious signs of illness will be requested to leave the grounds unless accompanied by a signed veterinarian statement that the animal is healthy. The decision of the show committee is final and entry fees will not be refunded.

**Remember to bring extra clothing and blankets if you're camping. The weather can be very cold at times.**

There will be a charge of \$6.00 per pen. Pens are 6' x 6'. Straw will be provided. Please indicate on your entry form the number of doe and buck pens you will need. **We are required to clean out our own pens, so please bring a rake to clean out the pens you use.** If you have animals that are jumpers or babies that might escape, please bring a cover for your pen or a suggestion for babies might be some green plastic netting available at supply stores. **Kids be ready to earn some money cleaning out the pens.**
