RULES

NPGA sanctioned. NPGA rules to govern and take precedence over all others. Only does and bucks with original registration papers or registration papers with transfers less than ninety (90) days old, will be allowed to show. Wethers do not need registration papers to be shown; however, they will be judged in accordance with the NPGA Breed Standard. In order for the Best Wether to record the win, the wether must be checked in with a "Certificate of Recorded Ancestry" and be identifiable by tattoo and/or microchip if the animal is over 6 months old. Other NPGA rules also apply.

Bring only healthy animals to the show. Animals having runny noses or eyes, coughs or other obvious signs of illness will be requested to leave the show unless accompanied by a signed veterinarian statement that the animal is healthy. The decision of the show committee is final and entry fees will not be refunded.

NPGA rules require that all animals 6 months of age or older must have a legible tattoo and/or microchip prior to being shown.

Although the Show Chair, Secretary or designee will check the registration papers prior to the goat being shown to ensure that each goat has been entered in the correct age class and division, **it is the ultimate responsibility of the exhibitor that the exhibitor's goat(s) is/are entered and shown in the correct age class and division.**

Exhibitors shall not show any doe or buck in an NPGA-sanctioned show with the herdname of the judge who is judging that show. For this show, the judges' herdnames are shown at the top of this page.

PROSPECT WETHER CLASS

The class will be the first wether class judged, but these goats will not compete for the Best Wether and Reserve Best Wether. Animals entered in this class may be registered as a wether already. The class is limited to goats between the age of 0 to 5 months that are going to be wethers, but that have not yet been castrated due to their young age.

PENS

A \$6.00 fee per pen will be charged for the weekend. Bedding will be provided. WE WILL **NOT** HAVE TO CLEAN UP THE PENS!
